

### **TRN-TI-FND Tech Illustrator Fundamentals**

This course teaches students how to use Auto-trol's Tech Illustrator (TI) software to create and modify artwork for illustrations in hardcopy publications, electronic books, and Web-publishing applications.

Students will use TI to import and manipulate reference data, create new artwork and finished illustrations, and save artwork to standard publishing data exchange formats.

Approximate course length: 4 days

Who should attend:

- Technical Illustrators
- Technical Authors

This course teaches students how to use:

- Standard data import publishing formats
- Graphics primitives and illustration construction tools (focus is on axonometric and orthogonal art)
- Editing tools for vector, raster, and composite graphics
- Masked symbols and clip art sheets
- Callout and annotation tools
- Illustrative rendering tools such as vignettes, stippling, and graduated tints
- Composing finished illustrations from component parts

#### Prerequisites:

- Background in technical illustration and computer-aided publishing
- Experience with Windows 2000 or Windows XP
